God's Answer to the Problems - The Power of The Holy Spirit

Jesus and the Holy Spirit were at the beginning.

John 1:1 (NKJV) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:2 (NKJV) He was in the beginning with God.

John 1:3 (NKJV) All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

Genesis 1:1 (NKJV) In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:2 (NKJV) The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

The Spirit of God came upon certain judges, warriors, and prophets in a way that gave them extraordinary power: for example, **Joshua** (Numbers 27:18), **Othniel** (Judges 3:10), **Gideon** (Judges 6:34), **Samson** (Judges 13:25; 14:6), and Saul

(1 Samuel 1	<u>10:9, 10</u>).			

John 14:26 (NKJV) But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

John 14:27 (NKJV) Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

John 15:26 (NKJV) "But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, **He will testify of Me**.
