2. A <u>Time</u> to Pray.	

The Hour of prayer/Times of prayer equals times of miracles in the Bible.

Prayer produces miracles.

Exodus 33:9 (NKJV) And it came to pass, when Moses entered the tabernacle, that the pillar of cloud descended and stood at the door of the tabernacle, and the Lord talked with Moses.

Exodus 33:11 (NKJV) So the Lord spoke to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend. And he would return to the camp, but his servant Joshua the son of Nun, a young man, did not depart from the tabernacle.

- 1 Kings 18:29 (AMP) Midday passed, and they played the part of prophets until the time for offering the evening sacrifice, but there was no voice, no answer, no one who paid
- 1 Kings 18:30 (AMP) Then Elijah said to all the people, Come near to me. And all the people came near him. And he repaired the [old] altar of the Lord that had been broken down [by Jezebel].
- 1 Kings 18:36 (NKJV) And it came to pass, at the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near and said, "Lord God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, let it be known this day that You are God in Israel and I am Your servant, and that I have done all these things at Your word.
- 1 Kings 18:37 (NKJV) Hear me, O Lord, hear me, that this people may know that You are the Lord God, and that You have turned their hearts back to You again."

Acts 2:1 (NKJV) When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

Acts 2:4 (NKJV) And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 2:15 (NKJV) For these are not drunk, as you suppose, since it is only the third hour of the day.

Acts 3. The miracle while going to the hour of prayer.

Acts 3:1 (NKJV) Now Peter and John went up together to the temple at the hour of **prayer**, the ninth hour.

Cornelius has his vision at the 3 PM hour prayer.

Acts 10:3 (NKJV) About the ninth hour of the day he saw clearly in a vision an angel of God coming in and saying to him, "Cornelius!"

Peter has a vision while praying at the sixth hour. 12 PM.

Acts 10:9 (NKJV) The next day, as they went on their journey and drew near the city, Peter went up on the housetop to pray, about the sixth hour.

Acts 16:25 (NKJV) But at midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to
