Matthew 5:40 (NKJV) If anyone wants to sue you and take away your tunic, let him have your cloak also.

Matthew 5:41 (NKJV) And whoever compels you to go one mile, go with him

Matthew 5:42 (NKJV) Give to him who asks you, and from him who wants to borrow from you do not turn away.

Matthew 5:43 (NKJV) "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.'

Matthew 4, Jesus tempted, Jesus begins His ministry.

Matthew 4:17 (NKJV) From that time Jesus **began to preach** and to say, "**Repent**, for the **kingdom of heaven** is at hand."

Repent, _to change one's life, based on complete change of attitude and thought concerning sin and righteousness.

Matthew 4:23 (NKJV) And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.

Matthew 4:24 (NKJV) Then His fame went **throughout all Syria**; and they brought to Him **all sick people** who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and **He healed them**.

Matthew 4:25 (NKJV) Great multitudes followed Him—from Galilee, and from Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan.

Matthew 5:1 (NKJV) And **seeing the multitudes**, He went up on a mountain, and when He was seated **His disciples came to Him**.

Matthew 5:2 (NKJV) Then He opened His mouth and taught them, saying:

Luke 6:20 (NKJV) Then **He lifted up His eyes toward His disciples**, and said: "Blessed are you poor, For **yours is the kingdom of God**.

Proverbs 23:7 (NKJV) For as he thinks in his heart, so is he. "Eat and drink!" he says to you, But his heart is not with you.

Proverbs 21:2 (AMP) Every man's way is right in his own eyes, But the LORD weighs *and* examines the hearts [of people and their motives].

Matthew 5:13 (NKJV) "You are the **salt of the earth**; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men.

Matthew 5:14 (NKJV) "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden.

Matthew 5:15 (NKJV) Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house.

Matthew 5:16 (NKJV) Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

Matthew 5:17 (NKJV) "Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to **fulfill**.

Matthew 5:18 (NKJV) For assuredly I say to you till heaven and earth pass

away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled. Matthew 5:19 (NKJV) Whoever therefore breaks one of the least of these commandments, and teaches men so, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever does and teaches them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 5:20 (NKJV) For I say to you, that unless your righteousness exceeds the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 5:21 (NKJV) "You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not murder, and whoever murders will be in danger of the judgment.'

Matthew 5:22 (NKJV) But I say to you that whoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment. And whoever says to his brother, 'Raca!' shall be in danger of the council. But whoever says, 'You fool!' shall be in danger of hell fire.

There are **wrong attitude** and **word actions** you can take too far

Matthew 5:23 (NKJV) Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you,

Matthew 5:24 (NKJV) leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way.

First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

Matthew 5:25 (NKJV) Agree with your adversary quickly, while you are on the way with him, lest your adversary deliver you to the judge, the judge hand you over to the officer, and you be thrown into prison.

Matthew 5:26 (NKJV) Assuredly, I say to you, you will by no means get out of there till you have paid the last penny.

Matthew 5:27 (NKJV) You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not commit adultery.'

Matthew 5:28 (NKJV) But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.

Matthew 5:29 (NKJV) If your right eye causes you to sin, pluck it out and cast it from you; for it is more profitable for you that one of your members perish, than for your whole body to be cast into hell.

Matthew 5:30 (NKJV) And **if your right hand causes** you to sin, **cut it off** and cast it from you; for it is more profitable for you that one of your members perish, than for your whole body to be cast into hell.

Matthew 5:31 (NKJV) "Furthermore it has been said, 'Whoever divorces his wife, let him give her a certificate of divorce.'

Matthew 5:32 (NKJV) But I say to you that whoever divorces his wife for any reason except sexual immorality causes her to commit adultery; and whoever marries a woman who is divorced commits adultery.

Matthow 19:8 (NK IV)
