6. Respond to Challenges with Joy and Patience

Trials during the holidays can refine your character and witness. Joy and patience become a testimony of God's strength in you.

James 1:2 (NKJV) My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, James 1:3 (NKJV) knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.

Philippians 4:4 (NKJV) Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!

Isaiah 40:31 (NKJV) But those who wait on the Lord Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.

7. Forgive Quickly and Freely

Forgiveness keeps your heart in the right place and reflects the heart of Christ.

Matthew 18:21-22 (NKJV) Then Peter came to Him and said, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Up to seven times?" Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven."

Ephesians 4:32 (NKJV) And be **kind** to one another, **tenderhearted**, **forgiving** one another, even **as God in Christ forgave you**.

Matthew 6:14 (NKJV) "For **if you forgive** men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you.

1 Corinthians 13:7 (NLT) Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance.

Romans 5:8 (NKJV) But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

1 Corinthians 16:14 (NKJV) Let all that you do be done with love.

2. Be a Witness Through Actions, Not Just Words

Matthew 5:16 (NKJV) Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

John 13:35 (NKJV) By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

3. Be Led by the Holy Spirit

1 John 4:4 (NKJV) You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

John 14:26 (NKJV) But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

Galatians 5:16 (NKJV) I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV) For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

4. Pursue Peace Actively

Peace is a fruit of the Spirit and requires intentional effort to sow it into relationships, even during conflicts.

Matthew 5:9 (NKJV) Blessed are the peacemakers, For they shall be called sons of God.

Romans 12:18 (NKJV) If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.

Psalm 34:14 (NKJV) Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it.

5. Be Compassionate and Aware of Others' Needs

Christmas is a season of giving; being sensitive to others' struggles can open doors for ministry and healing.

Ephesians 5:15 (NLT) So be careful how you live. Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise.

Ephesians 5:16 (NLT) Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days. Ephesians 5:17 (NLT) Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do.

Philippians 2:4 (NKJV) Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

Galatians 6:2 (NKJV) Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

Proverbs 19:17 (NKJV) He who has pity on the poor lends to the Lord, And He will pay back what he has given.
