**John 16:13 (AMP)** When He, the Spirit of Truth comes, **He will guide you into all** the Truth (the whole, full Truth). For He will not speak His own message [on His own authority]; but **He will tell whatever He hears [from the Father**; He will give the message that has been given to Him], and **He will announce and declare to you** the things that are to come [that will happen in the future].

Numbers 11:25 (NLT) And the Lord came down in the cloud and spoke to Moses. Then he gave the seventy elders the same Spirit that was upon Moses. And when the Spirit rested upon them, they prophesied. But this never happened again.

**Numbers 11:26 (NLT)** Two men, Eldad and Medad, had stayed behind in the camp. They were listed among the elders, but they had not gone out to the Tabernacle. Yet the Spirit rested upon them as well, so they prophesied there in the camp.

**Numbers 11:27 (NLT)** A young man ran and reported to Moses, "Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp!"

**Numbers 11:28 (NLT)** Joshua son of Nun, who had been Moses' assistant since his youth, protested, "Moses, my master, make them stop!"

Numbers 11:29 (NLT) But Moses replied, "Are you jealous for my sake? I wish that all the Lord's people were prophets and that the Lord would put his Spirit upon them all!"

Acts 2:17 (NLT) 'In the last days,' God says, 'I will pour out my Spirit upon all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy. Your young men will see visions, and your old men will dream dreams.

Acts 2:18 (NLT) In those days I will pour out my Spirit even on my servants—men and women alike— and they will prophesy.

## 10. The Holy Spirit is the same today as He was 2000 years ago.

**John 15:5 (NKJV)** "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

**John 15:6 (NKJV)** If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned.

John 15:7 (NKJV) If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

**John 15:8 (NKJV)** By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

John 17:20 (NKJV) "I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word;

John 17:21 (NKJV) that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.

John 17:22 (NKJV) And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one:

John 17:23 (NKJV) I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.					



# How To Be Led By God's Spirit - Week 1

Saturday-Sunday, June 15-16, 2024

### 1. We are created like God in order to commune with God.

**Genesis 1:27 (NKJV)** So God **created man in His own image**; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

**Genesis 1:28 (NKJV)** Then God blessed them, and **God said to them**, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Genesis 1:29 (NKJV) And God said, "See, I have given you every herb that yields seed which is on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed; to you it shall be for food.

Genesis 2:16-17 (NKJV) And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat...but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die."

## 2. There are other voices that compete for our attention.

Genesis 3:1 (NKJV) Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said to the woman, "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?"

**Genesis 3:2 (NKJV)** And **the woman said** to the serpent, "We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden;

Genesis 3:3 (NKJV) but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said. 'You shall not eat it. nor shall you touch it. lest you die.' "

## 3. Adam and Eve were familiar with God's voice and presence.

**Genesis 3:8 (NKJV)** And **they heard the sound of the Lord** God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife **hid themselves from the presence** of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

**Genesis 3:9 (NKJV)** Then **the Lord God called** to Adam and said to him, "Where are you?"

**Genesis 3:10 (NKJV)** So **he (Adam) said, "I heard Your voice** in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself."

**Genesis 3:13 (NKJV)** And **the Lord God said to the woman**, "What is this you have done?" **The woman said**, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

Genesis 4:26 (NKJV) Then men began to call on the name of the Lord.

### 5. God was very specific when communicating with His people.

**Genesis 6:13-15 (NKJV)** And **God said to Noah**, "The end of all flesh has come before Me, for the earth is filled with violence through them; and behold, I will destroy them with the earth...Make yourself an ark...And this is how you shall make it...

**Genesis 7:1-5 (NKJV)** Then **the Lord said to Noah**, "Come into the ark, you and all your household, because I have seen that you are righteous before Me in this generation... And **Noah did according** to all that the Lord **commanded him**.

**Genesis 9:1 (NKJV)** So **God blessed** Noah and his sons, and **said to them**: "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth.

Genesis 12:1-7 (NKJV) Now the Lord had said to Abram: "Get out of your country, From your family And from your father's house, To a land that I will show you...So Abram departed as the Lord had spoken to him...Then the Lord appeared to Abram and said, "To your descendants I will give this land."

**Genesis 15:1 (NKJV)** After these things **the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision**, saying, "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your exceedingly great reward."

Genesis 16, The Angel of the Lord meets and speaks with Hagar.

Genesis 18, Abraham prays for Sodom and Gomorrah. (Conversations with God)

**Genesis 19**, Angels speak with Lot in order to get him out of the city. Shortly afterward, Lot pleads with the Angels to allow him to stay in a small city called Zoar and the request is granted.

**Genesis 20**, God speaks to Abimelech in a dream. (Conversation)

**Genesis 21**, The angel of God speaks to Hagar about Ishmael.

## 6. Of all you take in daily, make God's Word your first priority.

2 Timothy 3:16 (NLT) All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right.

2 Timothy 3:17 (NLT) God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work

#### 7. Jesus became like us so we can be like Him.

**John 6:38 (AMP)** For **I have come down from heaven** not to do My own will and purpose but **to do the will and purpose of Him Who sent Me**.

Philippians 2:6 (AMP) Who, although being essentially one with God and in the form of God [possessing the fullness of the attributes which make God God], did not think this equality with God was a thing to be eagerly grasped or retained, Philippians 2:7 (AMP) But stripped Himself [of all privileges and rightful dignity], so as to assume the guise of a servant (slave), in that He became like men and was born a human being.

# 8. Jesus demonstrated a Father/Son relationship so we would have the same.

John 5:19 (NLT) So Jesus explained, "I tell you the truth, the Son can do nothing by himself. He does only what he sees the Father doing. Whatever the Father does, the Son also does.

John 5:30 (NLT) I can do nothing on my own. I judge as God tells me. Therefore, my judgment is just, because I carry out the will of the one who sent me, not my own will.

John 8:26 (NLT) I have much to say about you and much to condemn, but I won't. For I say only what I have heard from the one who sent me, and he is completely truthful."

**John 8:38 (NLT)** I am telling you **what I saw when I was with my Father**. But you are following the advice of your father."

# 9. We are better off today if we seek and yield ourselves to what the Father has made available.

John 16:7 (AMP) However, I am telling you nothing but the truth when I say it is profitable (good, expedient, advantageous) for you that I go away. Because if I do not go away, the Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Advocate, Intercessor, Strengthener, Standby) will not come to you [into close fellowship with you]; but if I go away, I will send Him to you [to be in close fellowship with you].

**John 16:8 (AMP)** And **when He comes, He will** convict and convince the world and bring demonstration to it about sin and about righteousness and about judgment:
