## The Great Commission

**Mark 16:15 (NKJV)** And He said to them, “**Go** into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.

**Mark 16:16 (NKJV)** He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

**Mark 16:17 (NKJV)** And **these signs will follow those who believe:** In My name they will **cast out demons**; they will **speak with new tongues**;

**Mark 16:18 (NKJV)** they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will **lay hands on the sick**, and **they will recover.**”

**Mark 16:19 (NKJV)** So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God.
