1 John 1:4 (NKJV) And these things we write to you that your joy may be full.

1 John 1:6 (NKJV) If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and **do not practice the truth.**

1 John 1:7 (NKJV)

But **if we walk in the light** as He is in the light, **we have fellowship with one another,** and the **blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.**

Jeremiah 29:13 (NLT) If you **look for me wholeheartedly**, you will find me.

John 17:1 (NKJV) Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You,

John 17:2 (NKJV) as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him.

John 17:3 (NKJV) And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

John 17:4 (NKJV) I have **glorified You on the earth. I have finished the work which You have given Me** to do.

John 17:5 (NKJV) And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

John 17:6 (NKJV) "I have **manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me** out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word.

John 17:7 (NKJV) Now **they have known** that all things which You have given Me are from You.

John 17:8 (NKJV) For **I have given to them the words which You have given Me**; and they have **received them**, and **have known surely** that I came forth from You; and they have believed that You sent Me.

John 17:9 (NKJV) "**I pray for them**. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours.

John 17:10 (NKJV) And all Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them.

John 17:11 (NKJV) Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are.

John 17:12 (NKJV) While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Your name. Those whom You gave Me I have kept; and none of them is lost except the son of perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled.

John 17:13 (NKJV) But now I come to You, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have My joy fulfilled in themselves.

John 17:14 (NKJV) I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.

John 17:15 (NKJV) I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one.

John 17:16 (NKJV) They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.

John 17:17 (NKJV)

Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.

John 17:18 (NKJV) **As You sent Me** into the world, **I also have sent them** into the world.

John 17:19 (NKJV) And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth.

John 17:20 (NKJV) "**I do not pray for these alone**, but also for **those who will believe in Me through their word**;

John 17:21 (NKJV) that **they all may be one**, as **You, Father, are in Me**, and **I in You**; that they also may be **one in Us**, that the **world may believe** that You sent Me.

John 17:22 (NKJV) And **the glory which You gave Me I have given them**, that **they may be one just as We are one**:

John 17:23 (NKJV) **in them, and You in Me**; that they may be made perfect in one, and that **the world may know** that You have sent Me, and **have loved them as You have loved Me**.
