**Philippians 4:13 (NKJV)** I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

**1 John 4:4 (NKJV)** You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

**Matthew 28:19 (NKJV)** Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,  
**Matthew 28:20 (NKJV)** teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Amen.

**Acts 1:8 (NKJV)** But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Identify one step you've hesitated on and take it this week.

## Righteousness Revealed—Accepted, Anointed, and Authorized

Sunday, March 8, 2026

### 1. God's Great Love – The Reason We Are Righteous

**Romans 5:8 (NKJV)** But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

**1 John 4:9 (NKJV)** In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him.

**1 John 4:10 (NKJV)** In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

**1 John 4:17 (NKJV)** Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world.

Jesus is accepted and loved. (So are we)

Jesus is seated at the right hand of God. (So are we)

The position of being seated means the work has been finished. (So is ours)

He is an Heir of God. (So are we) Romans 8:17

**Ephesians 2:4 (NKJV)** But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,

**(AMP)** Because of and in order to satisfy the great and wonderful and intense love with which He loved us

**Ephesians 2:5 (NKJV)** even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),

**Ephesians 2:6 (NKJV)** and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,

**Ephesians 2:7 (NKJV)** that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

**Ephesians 2:8 (NKJV)** For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,

**2 Corinthians 5:21 (NKJV)** For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

**Colossians 3:3 (NKJV)** For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.

**Colossians 3:4 (NKJV)** When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.

“God does not love us because Christ died for us;  
Christ died for us because God loved us.” — John R.W. Stott,

#### What To Do:

Reflect: How do I respond to such love today?

Action: Rest in God’s gift of righteousness—live from love, not for approval.

## 2. Aligning Your Life, Spirit, Soul, and Body—Empowered by the Holy Spirit

**Romans 12:2 (NKJV)** And do **not** be **conformed** to this world, but be **transformed** by the **renewing of your mind**, that **you may prove** what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

**Romans 6:13 (NKJV)** And **do not** present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, **but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead**, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

**John 15:4 (NKJV)** **Abide in Me, and I in you.** As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

**John 15:5 (NKJV)** “I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

**Romans 6:14 (NKJV)** For sin **shall not have dominion over you**, for you are not under law but **under grace**.

**2 Corinthians 10:5 (NKJV)** **casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God**, bringing **every thought into captivity** to the obedience of Christ,

**Romans 8:1 (NKJV)** There is therefore **now no condemnation** to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

**Romans 8:2 (NKJV)** For the **law of the Spirit of life** in Christ Jesus has **made me free** from the **law of sin and death**.

**Romans 6:16 (NKJV)** **Do you not know** that to **whom you present yourselves** slaves to obey, **you are that one’s slaves** whom you obey, **whether of sin** leading to death, or of **obedience** leading to righteousness?

#### What To Do:

Invite the Holy Spirit daily to guide your thoughts and choices.

Identify thoughts or habits that oppose God’s truth—replace them with His Word.

## 3. Walk Boldly in Your God-Given Authority—Speak Your Faith and Move Mountains

**Mark 11:22 (NKJV)** So Jesus answered and said to them, “Have faith in God. (*Greek: Have the God Kind of Faith or Have the Faith of God*)

**Mark 11:23 (NKJV)** For assuredly, I say to you, **whoever says** to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and **does not doubt in his heart**, but **believes** that those things he **says** will be done, he will have whatever he **says**.

**Mark 11:24 (NKJV)** Therefore I say to you, **whatever things** you ask when you pray, **believe** that you receive them, and you will have them.

**Romans 8:14 (NKJV)** For as many as are **led by the Spirit of God**, these are sons of God.

**1 John 2:20 (NKJV)** But you **have an anointing** from the Holy One, and **you know all things**.

**1 Peter 5:8 (NKJV)** Be **sober**, be **vigilant**; because **your adversary** the devil walks about like a roaring lion, **seeking** whom he may devour.

#### What To Do:

Identify a mountain—A major problem or obstacle in your life—speak God’s Word over it. Close enemy doors: align thoughts, beliefs, and words with God’s truth.

## 4. In Close Fellowship, God Reveals Plans Beyond our Imagination

**Jeremiah 29:11 (NKJV)** For I **know the thoughts** that I think toward you, says the Lord, **thoughts of peace** and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

**Ephesians 3:20 (AMP)** Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] **power that is at work within us**, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do **superabundantly, far over and above all** that we [dare] ask or think [**infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams**]—

**John 15:15 (NKJV)** No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have **called you friends**, for **all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you**.

#### What To Do:

Prioritize daily fellowship: prayer, listening, time in the Word.

Seek God’s heart before His plan—relationship precedes direction.
