

Ephesians 4:30 (GNB) And **do not make God's Holy Spirit sad**; for the Spirit is God's mark of ownership on you, a guarantee that the Day will come when God will set you free.

Ephesians 4:31 (GNB) **Get rid of all** bitterness, passion, and anger. No more shouting or insults, **no more** hateful feelings of any sort.

Ephesians 4:32 (GNB) **Instead, be kind and tender-hearted** to one another, and **forgive** one another, as God has forgiven you through Christ.

Practical Application:

Practice daily sensitivity to the Holy Spirit through prayer, the Word, and stillness. Yield to His prompts, even when they interrupt your plans.

7. We Are Overcomers — Walking in Christ's Victory

Romans 8:37 (NKJV) "Yet in **all these things we are more than** conquerors through Him who loved us."

1 John 4:4 (NKJV) "**He who is in you is greater** than he who is in the world."

Revelation 12:11 (NKJV) "And **they overcame him** by the **blood of the Lamb** and by the **word of their testimony...**"

Practical Application:

Don't fight for victory — fight from victory. Use your authority in Christ. Speak the Word, stand in faith, and overcome by truth.

Call to Action:

Receive: Embrace your "in Christ" identity.

Respond: Let the Holy Spirit work through you every day.

Represent: Be Jesus to your world — with boldness, love, and supernatural power.



MY CHURCH, Part 6: We Are the Hands and Feet of Jesus

1. We Are In Christ — A New Creation and a New Mission

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NKJV) Therefore, if anyone is **in Christ**, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, **all things have become new**.

2 Corinthians 5:18 (NKJV) Now **all things are of God**, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has **given us the ministry of reconciliation**,

2 Corinthians 5:19 (NKJV) that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

2 Corinthians 5:20 (NKJV) Now then, **we are ambassadors for Christ**, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.

2 Corinthians 5:21 (NKJV) For **He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us**, that we might become the **righteousness of God in Him**.

Ephesians 2:8 (NKJV) For **by grace** you have been **saved through faith**, and that not of yourselves; it is **the gift of God**,

Ephesians 2:9 (NKJV) not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Ephesians 2:10 (NKJV) For **we are His workmanship**, created in Christ Jesus for **good works**, which **God prepared beforehand** that we should **walk in them**.

Ephesians 2:13 (NKJV) But now in Christ Jesus you who **once were far off** have been **brought near by the blood of Christ**.

Practical Application:

Stop identifying with who you were. Live, think, and walk in your new identity — you are not just forgiven; you are empowered to live differently and purposefully.

2. We Are The Body Of Christ— His Expression on Earth

1 Corinthians 12:13 (NKJV) "For by one Spirit we were **all baptized into one body**—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have **all been made** to drink into one Spirit."

1 Corinthians 12:14 (NKJV) For in fact **the body is not one member but many**.

1 Corinthians 12:18 (NKJV) But now God has set the members, each one of them, in the body just as He pleased.

Ephesians 1:23 (NKJV) which is His body, **the fullness of Him** who fills all in all.

Practical Application:

Every believer is vital. Whether you're praying, serving, giving, or encouraging — you're letting Jesus touch the world through you.

3. We Are Gifted by the Spirit to Serve Supernaturally

1 Corinthians 12:1 (NKJV) Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, **I do not want you to be ignorant:**

1 Corinthians 12:7 (NKJV) “But **the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one** for the profit of all.”

Romans 12:6 (NKJV) “Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us...”

1 Peter 4:10 (NKJV) As **each one has received** a gift, **minister it** to one another, as **good stewards** of the manifold grace of God.

1 Peter 4:10 (NLT) **God has given each of you a gift** from his great variety of spiritual gifts. **Use them well to serve** one another.

Practical Application:

Identify and activate your spiritual gifts. Ask the Holy Spirit to use you. Don't sit on your gift — stir it up and let God work through you.

4. We Are Ambassadors of Christ — Representing Heaven's Kingdom

2 Corinthians 5:20 (NKJV) “Now then, **we are ambassadors** for Christ...”

Philippians 3:20 (NKJV)

For **our citizenship is in heaven**, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ,

John 17:15 (NKJV) **I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them** from the evil one.

John 17:16 (NKJV) They are **not of the world, just as I am not** of the world.

John 17:17 (NKJV) **Sanctify** them by Your truth. Your word is truth.

Matthew 5:14 (NKJV)

“**You are** the light of the world...”

Practical Application:

Your words, conduct, and love should reflect Christ. Speak boldly and live purely — you are a representative of the King.

5. We Are Called to Do Greater Works Through Christ in Us

John 14:12 (NKJV) “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, **the works that I do he will do also**; and **greater works** than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

John 14:13 (NKJV) And **whatever you ask in My name**, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

Ephesians 3:20 (NKJV) Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,

Colossians 1:27 (GNB) **God's plan is to make known his secret to his people**, this rich and glorious secret which **he has for all peoples**. And the **secret is that Christ is in you**, which means that **you will share in the glory of God**.

Practical Application:

Believe what God's Word says about you. Expect healings, words of wisdom, miracles, and divine appointments. Christ didn't just save you — He empowered you.

6. We Are Called to Cooperate with the Holy Spirit Daily

Galatians 5:25 (NKJV) “If we **live in the Spirit**, let us also **walk in the Spirit**.”

Romans 8:14 (NKJV) For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

Romans 8:14 (WUEST) For as many as are **being constantly led** by God's Spirit, **these are sons of God**.

Ephesians 4:29 (GNB) **Do not use harmful words**, but **only helpful words**, the kind that **build up and provide** what is needed, so that **what you say will do good** to those who hear you.
