Psalm 81:10 (NKJV) I am the Lord **your God**, Who **brought you out** of the land of Egypt; Open your mouth wide, and **I will fill it**.

Psalm 107:8 (NKJV) Oh, that men would **give thanks to the Lord for His goodness**, And for His wonderful works to the children of men!

Psalm 107:9 (NKJV) For **He satisfies** the longing soul, And **fills the hungry soul** with goodness.

Proverbs 3:9 (NKJV) **Honor the Lord with** your possessions, And **with the firstfruits of all your increase**;

Proverbs 3:10 (NKJV) **So your barns will be filled** with plenty, And your **vats will overflow** with new wine.

Proverbs 8:18 (NKJV) **Riches and honor are with me**, Enduring riches and righteousness.

Proverbs 8:20 (NKJV) I traverse the way of righteousness, In the midst of the paths of justice,

Proverbs 8:21 (NKJV) That I may **cause those who love me to inherit wealth**, That I may **fill their treasures**.

Revelation 22:1 (NKJV) And he showed me a **pure river of water of life**, clear as crystal, proceeding from the throne of God and of the Lamb.

Revelation 22:2 (NKJV) In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

Revelation 22:3 (NKJV) And **there shall be no more curse**, but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him.

Galatians 3:6 (NKJV) just as Abraham “believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.”

Galatians 3:7 (NKJV) Therefore know that only those who are of faith are sons of Abraham.

Galatians 3:8 (NKJV) And the Scripture, **foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel to Abraham** beforehand, saying, “**In you all the nations shall be blessed.**”

Galatians 3:9 (NKJV) So then **those who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham**.

Galatians 3:13 (NKJV) Christ **has redeemed us from the curse of the law**, having become a curse for us (for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”),

Galatians 3:14 (NKJV) **that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus**, that **we might receive** the promise of the Spirit through faith.

In the Old Testament, access was external, temporary, and mediated.

In the New Testament, access is internal, permanent, and personal through Jesus Christ.

Romans 8:14 (NKJV) For as many as are **led by the Spirit of God**, these are sons of God.

Romans 16:26 (NKJV) But now has been made manifest, and by the prophetic Scriptures has been made known to all nations, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, for **obedience to the faith**.

**Faith and obedience are not opposites;
faith is the root, obedience is the fruit.**

Faith is the seed, obedience is the harvest.

Faith is the inward conviction, obedience is the outward expression.

Faith trusts God's promise, obedience walks it out.

Faith believes, obedience proves.

Faith is the foundation, obedience is the building.

Galatians 3:29 (NKJV) And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

What Blessing Looks Like

Genesis 1:21 (NKJV) So God created great sea creatures and every living thing that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.

Genesis 1:22 (NKJV) And God blessed them, saying, "**Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth.**"

Genesis 1:27 (NKJV) So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

Genesis 1:28 (NKJV) Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "**Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.**"

Genesis 9:1 (NKJV) So God blessed Noah and his sons, and said to them: "**Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth.**"

Genesis 9:8 (NKJV) Then God spoke to Noah and to his sons with him, saying: **Genesis 9:9 (NKJV)** "And as for Me, behold, **I establish My covenant with you and with your descendants** after you,

Exodus 23:25 (NKJV) "So you shall serve the Lord your God, and He will **bless** your **bread** and your **water**. And I will **take sickness away** from the midst of you.

Exodus 23:26 (NKJV) **No one shall suffer miscarriage or be barren** in your land; I will **fulfill the number of your days**.

1 Timothy 4:4 (NKJV) For every creature of God is good, and nothing is to be refused if it is **received with thanksgiving**;

1 Timothy 4:5 (NKJV) for it is **sanctified by the word of God and prayer**.

Leviticus 26:4 (NKJV) then **I will give you rain in its season, the land shall yield** its produce, and the **trees** of the field **shall yield their fruit**.

Leviticus 26:5 (NKJV) Your threshing **shall last** till the time of vintage, and the vintage **shall last** till the time of sowing; **you shall eat your bread to the full, and dwell in your land safely**.

Leviticus 26:9 (NKJV) 'For I will look on you **favorably** and **make you fruitful, multiply you** and confirm My covenant with you.

Leviticus 26:10 (NKJV) You shall eat the old harvest, and **clear out the old because of the new**.

What Disobedience Looks Like

Leviticus 26:16 (NKJV) I also will do this to you: I will even appoint terror over you, wasting disease and fever which shall consume the eyes and cause sorrow of heart. And you shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it.

Leviticus 26:19 (NKJV) I will break the pride of your power; I will make your heavens like iron and your earth like bronze.

Leviticus 26:20 (NKJV) And your strength shall be spent in vain; for your land shall not yield its produce, nor shall the trees of the land yield their fruit.

Leviticus 26:26 (NKJV) When I have cut off your supply of bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall bring back your bread by weight, and you shall eat and not be satisfied.
