3. **WHEN READING YOUR BIBLE, LOOK FOR GOD'S LOVE, CHARACTER AND WILLINGNESS TO WORK IN YOU AND THROUGH YOU.** John 5:39 (NKJV), John 14:8-9 (NKJV)
4. **AS WE BECOME MORE CLOSELY CONNECTED TO OUR LORD, EXPECT TRANSFORMATION TO TAKE PLACE.** 2 Corinthians 3:18 (NKJV), John 15:4-7 (NKJV), John 17:16 (NKJV), John 17:17-19 (NKJV)
5. **WE HAVE EVERYTHING WE NEED.** Ephesians 1:3 (NKJV), 2 Peter 1:2-4 (NKJV)

THE PROCESS OF TRANSFORMATION

Romans 12:1 (NKJV)

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that **you present your bodies** a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your **reasonable** service.

Romans 12:2 (NKJV)

And **do not be conformed to this world**, but **be transformed** by the **renewing of your mind**, that **you may prove** what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Transformation only occurs when the mind is renewed.

Rom. 12:2, “**the renewing (of your mind),**” the adjustment of the moral and spiritual vision and thinking to the mind of God, which is designed to have a transforming effect upon the life;

Romans 12:2 (NKJV) **Transformed** [G3339]. Used in 4 scriptures.

Matthew 17:2 & Mark 9:2 (KJV) And was **transfigured**[G3339] before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.

2 Corinthians 3:18 (KJV) But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are **changed**[G3339] into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

“**In this life, your ability is limited, however, you are not limited to your ability.**”

You repent to be forgiven, but you must surrender to be changed.

Reasoning always leads to one of two things: confusion or a conclusion.

Joshua 1:6 (NKJV)

Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them.

Joshua 1:7 (NKJV)

Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go.

Joshua 1:8 (NKJV)

This **Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth,** but **you shall meditate in it day and night,** that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For **then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.**

Joshua 1:9 (NKJV)

Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is **with you wherever you go.**”

Romans 8:5 (NKJV)

For **those who live according** to the flesh **set their minds on the things of the flesh,** but those who **live according** to the Spirit, **the things of the Spirit.**

Romans 8:6 (NKJV)

For to be **carnally minded is death,** but to be **spiritually minded is life and peace.**

Romans 8:7 (NKJV)

Because **the carnal mind is enmity against God;** for it is **not subject** to the law of God, **nor in-deed can be.**

Mark 4:11 (NKJV)

And He said to them, “To you it has been given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God; but to those who are outside, all things come in parables,

Mark 4:13 (NKJV)

And He said to them, “**Do you not understand** this parable? **How then** will you understand all the parables?

Mark 4:14 (NKJV)

The sower **sows the word.**

Mark 4:24 (NKJV)

Then He said to them, “**Take heed what you hear.** With the same **measure you use,** it will be **measured to you;** and to **you who hear, more will be given.**

Mark 4:25 (NKJV)

For **whoever has,** to him **more will be given;** but whoever **does not have,** even what he has will be taken away from him.”

Mark 4:26 (NKJV)

And He said, “**The kingdom of God is as if a man should scatter seed on the ground,**

Mark 4:27 (NKJV)

and should **sleep by night and rise by day,** and the **seed should sprout and grow,** he himself **does not know how.**

Mark 4:28 (NKJV)

For **the earth yields crops by itself:** first **the blade,** then **the head,** after that **the full grain in the head.**

Luke 8:10 (NKJV)

And He said, “**To you it has been given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God,** but to the rest it is given in parables, that ‘Seeing they may not see, And hearing they may not understand.’

Luke 8:11 (NKJV)

“Now the parable is this: **The seed is the word of God.**

Therefore **take heed how you hear.** For **whoever has,** to him **more will be given;** and **whoever does not have,** even **what he seems to have will be taken from him.**

Proverbs 4:20 (NLT)

My child, **pay attention** to what I say. **Listen carefully** to my words.

Proverbs 4:21 (NLT)

Don’t lose sight of them. **Let them penetrate deep** into your heart,

Proverbs 4:22 (NLT)

for **they bring life** to those who find them, and **healing to their whole body.**

Proverbs 4:23 (NLT)

Guard your heart above all else, for it **determines the course of your life.**
