Romans 12:1 (NKJV) I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that **you present your bodies** a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

Romans 12:2 (NKJV) And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Transformation is not about what you can do in the Spirit but with the Spirit can do in you

Too many believers pray in the Spirit then gossip and complain in English

Galatians 5:16 (NLT) So I say, **let the Holy Spirit** guide your lives. Then **you won't be doing** what your sinful nature craves.

Galatians 5:17 (NLT) The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are the opposite of what the sinful nature desires. These two forces are constantly fighting each other, so you are not free to carry out your good intentions.

Galatians 5:18 (NLT) But when you are directed by the Spirit, you are not under obligation to the law of Moses.

Galatians 5:19 (NLT) When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, **the results are very clear**: sexual immorality, impurity, lustful pleasures,

Galatians 5:20 (NLT) idolatry, sorcery, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, dissension, division,

Galatians 5:21 (NLT) envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other sins like these. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that **anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God**.

Galatians 5:22 (NLT) But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

Galatians 5:23 (NLT) gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!
Galatians 5:24 (NLT) Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to his cross and crucified them there.

Galatians 5:25 (NLT) Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit's leading in every part of our lives.

Characteristics of a Mature Transformed Believer

1. Lives in Close Fellowship with Christ (Abides in Christ)

John 15:4 (NKJV) "Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me."

John 15:5 (ESV) "I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing."

Colossians 2:6-7 (NLT) "And now, just as you accepted Christ Jesus as your Lord, you must continue to follow him. Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him."

2. Walks in Love

1 Corinthians 13:1-2 (ESV) "If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal."

1 John 4:7-8 (NKJV) "Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. He who does not love does not know God, for God is love."

Ephesians 5:2 (NASB) "And walk in love, just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God as a fragrant aroma."

3. Has Developed the Fruit of the Spirit in Their Life

Galatians 5:22-23 (NKJV) "But the **fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control."

Ephesians 5:8 (NKJV) For **you were once** darkness, but **now you are** light in the Lord. **Walk as children of light**

Ephesians 5:9 (NKJV) (for the **fruit of the Spirit** is in all **goodness**, **righteousness**, and **truth**),

Ephesians 5:10 (NKJV) finding out what is acceptable to the Lord.

Colossians 1:9 (NKJV) For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;

Colossians 1:10 (NKJV) that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

4. Resists Yielding to the Desires of the Flesh

Galatians 5:16 (NLT) "So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves."

Romans 8:13 (NKJV) "For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live."

1 Peter 2:11 (ESV) "Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from the passions of the flesh, which wage war against your soul."

5. Resists Pride and Strives for Humility

Philippians 2:3 (ESV) "Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves."

James 4:10 (NASB) "**Humble yourselves** in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you."

1 Peter 5:5 (NKJV) "Likewise you younger people, **submit yourselves** to your elders. Yes, **all of you be submissive to one another**, and be **clothed with humility**, for 'God **resists the proud**, but gives **grace to the humble**.'"

6. Endures Trials with Patience and Kindness

James 1:2 (NKJV) My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, James 1:3 (NKJV) knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.

James 1:4 (NKJV) But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

Romans 5:3-4 (ESV) "Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope."

7. Pursues Peace and Unity

Romans 12:18 (ESV) "If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all."

Ephesians 4:3 (NKJV) "Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace."

Hebrews 12:14 (NASB) "Pursue peace with all men, and the sanctification without which no one will see the Lord."

8. Practices Self-Control

2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV) "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind."

Titus 2:11-12 (ESV) "For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, **training us to renounce ungodliness** and **worldly passions**, and to **live self-controlled**, **upright**, and **godly lives**."

Proverbs 25:28 (NASB) "Like a city that is broken into and without walls is a man who has no control over his spirit."

9. Speaks Truth in Love

Ephesians 4:15 (ESV) "Rather, **speaking the truth in love**, we are to **grow up in every way** into him who is the head, into Christ."
