

Point 4 – Abundant Life: Walking in Victory Over the Works of the Devil

Believers in general must break free from the “sit and soak” mentality and move into the “share and serve” mentality.

Romans 8:2 (NKJV) “For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.”

Galatians 5:16 (NKJV) “I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.”

1 John 4:4 (NKJV) “You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.”

Mark 16:17-18 (NKJV) “And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”

FROM BONDAGE TO FULLNESS IN CHRIST SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2025

John 10:10 (NKJV) “The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.”

1 John 3:8 (NKJV) For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.”

Point 1 – Delivered from Egypt: The New Birth

Exodus 14:13-14 (NKJV) “And Moses said to the people, ‘Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace.’”

Exodus 14:27-28 (NKJV) “And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and when the morning appeared, the sea returned to its full depth, while the Egyptians were fleeing into it. So the Lord overthrew the Egyptians in the midst of the sea. Then the waters returned and covered the chariots, the horsemen, and all the army of Pharaoh that came into the sea after them. Not so much as one of them remained.”

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NKJV) “Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.”

Colossians 1:13-14 (NKJV) “He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.”

Practical Application: To **Know God** is to personally experience His deliverance and lordship. We must **Surrender** our heart to Jesus. Time in God's Word and prayer allows Holy Spirit to reveal who He truly is. Stop looking back at Egypt—your past is buried. Begin walking as one who knows God intimately and lives in His freedom.

Point 2 – Crossing the Jordan: The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Joshua 3:14-17 (NKJV) “So it was, **when the people set out** from their camp **to cross over** the Jordan, with the priests bearing the ark of the covenant before the people, and as those who bore the ark **came to the Jordan**, and the feet of the priests who bore the ark dipped in the edge of the water... that **the waters** which came down from upstream **stood still**, and the people crossed over opposite Jericho.”

Acts 1:8 (NKJV) “But **you shall receive power** when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Acts 2:4 (NKJV) “And **they were all filled** with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.”

“Being filled with the Spirit is not a one-time event; it's a lifestyle of continual surrender.” — R.A. Torrey

Practical Application: To **Find Freedom**, seek God for help, join a small group (Freedom), attend church and learn about what God has planned for you. Freedom is more than deliverance; it's living empowered by His presence. The Spirit sets you free inwardly so you can walk free outwardly.

Point 3 – The Renewed Mind: Transformation into His Image

Joshua 1:5-9 (NKJV) ...**as I was** with Moses, so **I will be** with you. I will **not leave you** nor forsake you...**Be strong** and of good courage... so you will **observe to do** what Moses commanded...**Don't waver** and you will prosper...I'm going with you.

Joshua 1:8 (NKJV) This Book of the Law shall **not depart from your mouth**, but you shall **meditate** in it **day and night**, that **you may observe to do** according to all that is written in it. For **then you will make your way** prosperous, and then **you will have good success**.

Joshua 1:8 (NET Bible) This law scroll **must not leave your lips!** You must **memorize it day and night** so you can carefully obey all that is written in it. Then you will prosper and be successful.

Joshua 1:8 (Bishops' Bible of 1568) Let not the booke of this lawe departe out of thy mouth , but **occupie thy minde therein day & night**,

Joshua 1:8 (Coverdale Bible of 1535) And let not the boke of this lawe departe out of thy mouth, but **exerceyse thy selfe therin daie and nighte**,

Romans 12:1-2 (NKJV) “I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that **you present** your bodies a **living sacrifice**, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And **do not be conformed** to this world, but **be transformed** by the **renewing of your mind**, that **you may prove** what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.”

Ephesians 4:22-24 (NKJV) “That **you put off**, concerning your **former conduct**, the **old man** which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and **be renewed in the spirit of your mind**, and that **you put on the new man** which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.”

2 Corinthians 3:18 (NKJV) “But **we all**, with unveiled face, **beholding** as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are **being transformed** into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.”

Practical Application: To **Discover Purpose**, spend time in God's Word until your identity becomes clear. Let the Spirit reveal your gifts, calling, and destiny. Transformation happens when you allow the Word to replace worldly thinking with kingdom vision.
