

Application: The believer doesn't need to ask God to fight Satan—he is to **resist, bind,** and **cast out**.

C. Authority Over the Flesh

Galatians 5:16 (NKJV) “Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.”

Romans 8:13 (NKJV) “If by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.”

1 Corinthians 9:27 (NKJV) “But I discipline my body and bring it into subjection...”

Application: The believer has the Holy Spirit and the Word to **train and discipline** the body (flesh), not obey it.



Redeemed - Part 6 – God's Rescue Plan

1. WHO the Believer is:

A. Every Believer is a New Creation

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NKJV) “Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.”

- His spirit is completely regenerated—made alive unto God. He is no longer spiritually dead.

B. Every Believer is a Child of God

John 1:12 (NKJV) “But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name.”

- His sins are not merely forgiven but now is a child in God's family.

Romans 8:15-16 (NKJV) “For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption... The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God.”

C. Joint-Heir with Christ

Romans 8:17 (NKJV) “And if children, then heirs—heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ...”

- All that Christ has inherited spiritually is now legally shared with the believer.

2. WHAT the Believer Has Been Given:

A. The Gift of Righteousness

Romans 5:17 (NKJV) “...those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.”

- Righteousness is not earned; it is a gift that gives the believer the right-standing with God.

2 Corinthians 5:21 (NKJV) “For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.”

B. The Holy Spirit Within

1 Corinthians 6:19 (NKJV) “Do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you...?”

Romans 8:11 (NKJV) “But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He... will also give life to your mortal bodies...”

C. The Authority of Christ

Luke 10:19 (NKJV) “Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy...”

Ephesians 2:6 (NKJV) “...and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.”

Mark 16:17 (NKJV) “And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons...”

D. The Word of God and Faith

Romans 10:17 (NKJV) “So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.”

Hebrews 4:12 (NKJV) “For the word of God is living and powerful...”

3. WHAT The Believer Has Been Removed From and Redeemed To.

Removed From:

A. Spiritual Death

Ephesians 2:1 (NKJV) “And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins.”

B. The Curse of the Law (Sin, Sickness, Poverty)

Galatians 3:13 (NKJV)
“Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us...”

C. Satan’s Dominion

Colossians 1:13 (NKJV) “He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love...”

Redeemed To:

A. Eternal Life

John 10:10 (NKJV) “I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.”

B. The Blessing of Abraham

Galatians 3:14 (NKJV) “That the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus...”

C. Sonship and Inheritance

Ephesians 1:5 (NKJV) “...having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself...”

4. Believer’s Authority Concerning Sin, The Devil, and The Flesh.

A. Authority Over Sin

Romans 6:14 (NKJV) “For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.”

Romans 6:6-7 (NKJV) “...our old man was crucified with Him... that we should no longer be slaves of sin.”

Application: The believer has the **right and power** to say **no** to sin, because his spirit is alive to God and dead to sin.

B. Authority Over the Devil

James 4:7 (NKJV) “Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.”

1 John 4:4 (NKJV) “He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.”

Revelation 12:11 (NKJV)

“ And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony...”
